BOTTLE BILL
BACKGROUND: lowa's bottle bill has been a huge success, and recent polling shows that 8 out of every 10 lowans supports lowa's bottle redemption law, a percentage that does not change significantly with party affiliation. Statistics show that states with deposit laws have much higher beverage recycling rates. In lowa, 76% of plastic (PET) cabornated bottles are recovered, compared to only 26% of non-bottle bill covered PET bottles. Iowa still loses over \$26 million in beverage redemptions, which are kept by distributers each year, an amount that could add significantly to the state's recycling infrastructure.
